ARC (AgriLife Research Cloud)

- Identified a significant gap
 - Researchers throughout college reliant on department IT resources for basic support (problem with monitor, keyboard, printer, etc.)
 - Typically researchers need more advanced help that the basic support staff could not complete or did not have the training to do so
- The ARC service center is what offers advance managed IT services in support of the research programs
 - Charge around \$58/hour
- Alex Guess Business manager for ARC service center
 - Already started to take on customers (4 of them right now, 2 more in the pipeline)
- Offers Research Consulting
 - When researchers are trying to determine budgetary needs for IT hardware/software, ARC is the resource to come and consult to determine what they need to buy
- Training and Collaboration
- Every researcher wants to be compliant and secure, but aren't experts in this area, so ARC provides these services as a courtesy
 - Kerry Pickens will provide risk assessments for research programs
